- Chablis 11. Chablis 2008, William Fèvre £26.95 £6.50  
Refined on the nose with fruit & citrus notes, fresh and subtle with a pleasant flinty finish.
12. Chablis Premier Cru 2007, Les Vaillons £36.95  
Delicate yet powerful wine with flint mineral character and an elegant nose.
13. Chablis Grand Cru Vaudesir 2003, Domaine William Fèvre £44.95  
Extremely rich nose, marked by an intense mineral character. On the palate it is firm and massive, with remarkable full and long flavour.
- Alsace 14. Gewurztraminer 2007 £27.95  
Spices and herbs are the focal point of this dry but floral wine from Alsace on the French German border.
- Australia 15. Yering Station Chardonnay 2006 £28.95 £6.75  
Pale and straw in colour with a pure complex nose of flinty, mineral characters as well as citrus with some almond. The palate is clean, fresh and well integrated with oak character.
- New Zealand 18. Mansion House Bay, Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc 2008 £26.95 £6.25  
Classic lychee and gooseberry nose with hints of tropical fruits and nettle leaf on the palate. This wine comes from three sites in the Awatere and Wairau valleys and the combination gives rise to the complex and intense aromas that are the hallmark of Marlborough.

- Chile 1. Soleus Organic Sauvignon Blanc 2008 – Chile £16.95 £4.50  
A quality wine crafted from organically grown grapes from prime estates in Chile's renowned Central Valley. This is a limited production wine that is crisp and juicy with mineral notes that give it a lively finish.
- Spain 21. Fransola Sauvignon Blanc 2008, Miguel Torres £23.95  
Made with 90% Sauvignon Blanc and 10% Parellada this wine offers smokey nuances with peach and apricots on the nose.
- Germany 23. Schmitt Sohne Riesling Kabinett 2006 £16.95 £4.75  
Buckets of fruit but a refreshing lightness of touch abound in this German favourite.
- Lebanon 25. Mosaic – Chateau Musar 2007 £23.95  
With a note of pineapple, citrus fruits and jasmine flowers all following through the palate. Using the lesser known Aromatic Vermentino grape, this wine is refreshing with a vibrant, crisp finish.
- U.S.A 26. Marimar Chardonnay 2004 £34.95  
A Russian River Valley superstar produced by the prodigal daughter of Don Torres. A rich, powerful yet perfectly balanced Chardonnay, could be mistaken for a fine Meursault
- Italy 28. Pinot Grigio Via Nova £20.95  
A crisp and characterful version of this Italian classic. This light, slightly spicy white wine is gently perfumed, showing flavours of fresh peach and lemon with a delicate, dry and nutty finish.
- England 29. Gribble Bridge, Dry Ortega 2007 £21.95 £5.50  
Produced on a south facing slope of the 22 acre Biddenden vineyard in Kent, this wine has a fresh fruity character and off dry style perfect with poultry, seafood and salads.

	This wine is of medium weight with a spicy and expansive opulence. It is well structured with great flair and elegance.		
	52. Vosne-Romanee Aux Reignos 1998, Bouchard	£65.95	
	With its intense and complex bouquet its power is balanced with a smoothness and perfect acidity.		
	54. Beaune 1er Cru Grèves Vigne de l'Enfant Jésus 2003	£70.95	
	This vineyard which formerly belonged to the Carmelite nuns of Beaune was acquired by the Bouchard family after the French Revolution in 1791. It is one of the oldest properties and one of the flagships of the Bochart Pere et Fils estate. The wine has a superb bouquet of fruit and spice with a touch of oak. Intense, full and delicate wine with ravishing velvet overtones.		
Rhone	47. Côtes Du Rhône Rouge 2006, Guigal	£19.95	
	Best vintage for some years. Full bodied Packed with a higher proportion of syrah. Superb fruit and balance.		
	48. Chateauneuf du Pape 2003, Guigal	£42.95	
	A plethora of grape varieties are brought together to produce this elegant classic.

- Bordeaux 55. Chateau De Lardiley 2003 £19.95 £4.95  
Honest to goodness Bordeaux wine comprised of 60% Merlot and 40% Cabernet Sauvignon producing ripe fruit aromas with oaky notes and velvety tannins.
- St. Emilion 57. Chateau Lassegue 2000 Grand Cru £54.95  
This wine displays its character and class with ripe tannins, concentrated currant and berry fruit flavours and tones of spicy oak and chocolate.
- Montagne  
St. Emilion 58. Chateau Roudier 2001 £34.95  
The wine is aromatic, splendidly concentrated with firm tannins and fruit confit flavours. Beautifully balanced, this is one of the top wines in its district.
- Medoc 59. Chateau Tour St Bonnet 2001 £28.95  
Located in the South-west of France, in the area of Bordeaux, the Medoc has some of the most prestigious red wine vintages in France. This example is reasonably concentrated, smooth and accessible with ripe blackcurrant style fruit.  
60. Chateau Rousseau De Sipian 2000 £23.95  
This wine may lack some of the finesse of the Haut-Medoc yet it has a robust character and well pronounced body which is uncommon of such a good value wine.
- Haut-Medoc 61. Tour Haut Moulin 2000 £49.95  
This wine is classically modelled Haut Medoc. Its tannins are solid and of good quality. The wine is matured for 18 months in casks and comes across with elements of aniseed, vanilla and woodland scent.  
62. Chateau Citran Cru Bourgeois 2001 £53.95  
Another fine example of classic Haut Medoc wine with good tannins and plenty of ripe fruit flavour including berries and cherry.
- St. Estephe 63. Chateau Vignolle Marbuzet 1996 Cru Artisan £42.50  
The wine is amouth watering creation with aromas of cedar wood and blackcurrant. The tannins are supple and it is full in body and fruit with good depth and balance.

69. Yering Station Pinot Noir 2008 £27.95  
This wine is a great example of Yarra valley Pinot Noir with uplifted aromas, silky palate & a lingering finish.
70. Peter Lehmann My Word Is My Bond Shiraz 2008 £22.95 £5.50  
Deep garnet rim with a black centre. Lashings of dark chocolate on the nose. Showing all the classic richness of Barossa Shiraz with superb depth of fruit reined in by fine chalky tannins.
71. Stepping Stone Cabernet Sauvignon £24.95 £6.25  
This soft and flavoursome wine shows characters of red currant, blackberry and chocolate- mint with a smooth texture and ripe tannins.
72. Skillogee Cabernet Sauvignon Cabernet Franc 2005 £28.95  
This wine is blended with a small amount of Malbec and gives a soft palate with full fruit flavours, rich vanillin oak and fine tannins on a lingering finish.
75. Ebenezer Cabernet Sauvignon Merlot 1999 £42.95  
This wine displays the richness and complexity for which the Barossa Valley is known. This wine displays rich blackberry & plum flavours complemented by subtle well-balanced oak. It's a great wine & back on our list after an absence of several years.

- Italy 78. Barrua 2003, Agricola Punica £54.95  
Barrua is the first wine of the joint-venture between prestigious Sardinian winery Cantina Sociale di Santadi and Tenuta San Guido, home of Marchese Niccolo Incisa and perhaps more importantly, Sassicaia. The first release the 2002 is a blend of 85% Carignano, 10% Cab Sauv & 5% Merlot
79. Fonterutoli Chianti Classico 2007 £29.95  
Produced from different Sangiovese clones, this important Chianti Classico, concentrated, elegant and complex ages for 12 months in small oaked barrels
- Spain 81. RiojaReserva Marques de Riscal 2005 £27.95  
Using 15 year old Tempranillo vines with 10% Graciano grapes, this wine has a dark cherry colour with good depth. It has balsamic aromas with hints of ripe fruit. The finish prove persistent with reminders of toasted oak and its passage through the mouth is pleasant, elegant and easy drinking.
82. Gran Coronas – Cabernet Sauvignon 2004 £23.95 £5.95  
This wine has an intense aroma, a fruity and generous silky smooth palate with elegant density.
83. Mas La Plana – Cabernet Sauvignon 2005 £36.95  
Harvested on 26<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> September, this is quite possibly Penedes best single varietal Cabernet Sauvignon.
- Chile 85. Cordillera 2006 £23.95  
A spectacular blend of grapes varieties from ancient vines. The practice of non-grafting means that the vines are unchanged from those imported from France before the devastating outbreak of Phloxera.
86. Manso de Velasco 2005 £39.95  
Extraordinarily rich aromas of ripe fruit. Its aristocratic Cabernet Sauvignon tannins have a majestic, regal structure, heightened by the creamy background from long barrel-ageing.
87. Don Amado 2005 £45.95  
This outstanding wine celebrates the heritage of the winery's founder, Amado Paredes. Elaborated with only the finest & most noble cabernet sauvignon & merlot vintages, it evokes the imagery of both his passion for winemaking & the region from which it comes, the Cachapoal Valley in the heart of Chile's wine country.
- Argentina 89. Chakana Malbec Mendoza 2009 £21.95  
Produced at the Chakana winery located 3,300 feet in the Andes highlands, this wine offers intense fruit flavours and a lasting deep, rich finish.
- U.S.A. 92. Marimar Pinot Noir 2003 £39.95  
A Russian River Valley superstar produced by the prodigal daughter of Don Torres. Unfiltered thus giving a becoming fullness and depth.

111. Henriot Millésimé 1996		£81.95
Henriot pays homage to vintages of grace and strength. The blend meticulously preserves the spirit of the year... Henriot Vintage Brut is a Champagne of complex ample expression which reaches maturity later than the Brut Souverain. - IWC 2004 Gold Medal Winner		
112. Henriot Cuvée des Enchanteleurs 1990		£139.95
1990 is regarded as one of the finest vintages to date, and benefited from a very regular growing cycle, excellent late ripening conditions and thirteen years on the lees. This wine is a blend of 57% Chardonnay from the Cotes de Blancs and 43% pinot Noir from the Montagne de Reims.
